

- 1. On your third day of joining a new Hospital, a physician comes into your office and asks for advice. The physician has received data from an ongoing clinical trial, in which case they have collected health-related quality of life (HRQoL) from patients. One patient has reported the following HRQoL:
  - From baseline (0 months) and until 6-month follow-up: 0.62
  - From 6 months follow-up and until 12-months follow-up: 0.8
  - a) Explain what is meant by quality-adjusted life-years (QALYs)
  - b) Draw a QALY diagram and calculate the associated QALYs during the time from baseline until the 12-month follow-up.
- 2. The hospital is deciding between alternative rehabilitation programs (E1, E2, and E3), which are mutually exclusive. The following table shows the QALYs gained, and costs are measured against the alternative of doing nothing.

Programs	Cost (US\$)	QALY gain	
E1	250,000	87	
E2	170,000	60	
E3 .	90,000	62

You have been given a context of patient referral system. Based on the given context below develop a research question, objectives, propose data collection method, select participants, develop data collection guidelines, and data analysis plan for an exploratory (anthropological) research in the hospital setting of a low-resource country like Bangladesh.

#### **Context:**

Patient referral to hospitals, specialists and other health facilities is an essential part of primary health care (PHC). Patients are referred to specialists when investigation or therapeutic options are exhausted in primary care or when option or advice is needed from them. Competent referral system has considerable impact for patients, health care system and health care costs. There is no strong referral system in Asian countries, including Bangladesh, and any patient can go to any level of health care facility without any referral. This poses a burden on the secondary and tertiary level hospitals or health settings where a large number of patients with minor ailments throng the outpatient departments (OPD) and increases the bulk of patients who can be easily tacked at the lower level health care setting.
